

Fuel Policy



The purpose of this document is to set out the terms and conditions for which the Canterbury Crocodiles Dodgeball Club Committee (herein referred to as 'the Committee') will request fair fees for drivers

Rationale

Previously, drivers may be in an uncomfortable position of trying to collect fuel money for themselves after driving members to and from competitions. We have previously had no structure to this and drivers would receive money often not relating to a fair amount for fuel and driving expenses.

The new approach

Members driving to competitions on behalf of the club will receive 25p per mile (£0.25) and any tolls or parking fees. The total cost will be split between all members in the car (including the driver). Members requiring lifts will do their best to ensure the driver does not have to leave the route they are taking, i.e. members will make their way to a pre-agreed location to meet the driver.

Example:

Member A drives members B, C and D from X to Y, back to X. The total distance for this trip is 320 miles as well as £5 worth of tolls. The total price of the drive is £85. Each person in the car will then send the driver £21.25. The driver would then receive £63.75 as well as their own contribution of £21.25.

Example of costs not split:

If a driver receives any sort of fine (speeding, parking etc) these costs will not be split with the members they took.
